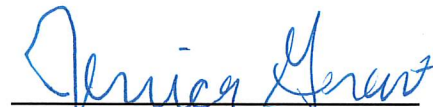

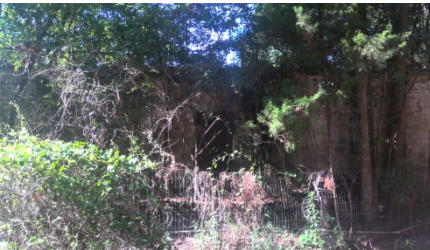

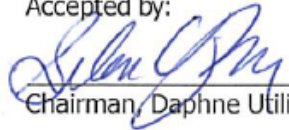

He then commented on Items of Note relating to: assembling applications and finalizing arrangements for the upcoming new session of the Leadership Academy; the positive progress of this year's summer interns; the 3 projects submitted for the GOMESA grants; ongoing evaluations for a new well site at the Trojan Water Plant with positive feedback from the geologist; and concluded with completion of the prepaid gas agreement with the appropriate discount and commended Mr. Speegle for helping to move this agreement to a close.

Mayor Robin LeJeune asked about the Fairhope Gas incident at W.J. Carroll involving the sidewalks; Mr. Polk responded that this may have been due to a water-main break. Mr. Godfrey confirmed that Fairhope Gas is on the west side and Daphne Utilities is on the east.

Councilman Joel Coleman asked about the Loma Alta tank being brought back online; Mrs. Melinda Immel with Volkert explained the reason for a delay and had been informed by the contractor that they should meet the deadline, which is mid-July.

B. Operations Report

While Chief Operations Officer Alex Godfrey had nothing to add to his submitted report, he informed the Board that Chris Leonard, who was the Water Quality Manager, decided to permanently retire and after interviews and consideration, the position was offered to Mr. Ryan Thomley who is dual certified water and wastewater. Mr. Thomley was hired only four weeks prior for a WRF position and after an impressive interview for the manager position, accepted and is making rapid progress.

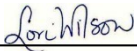

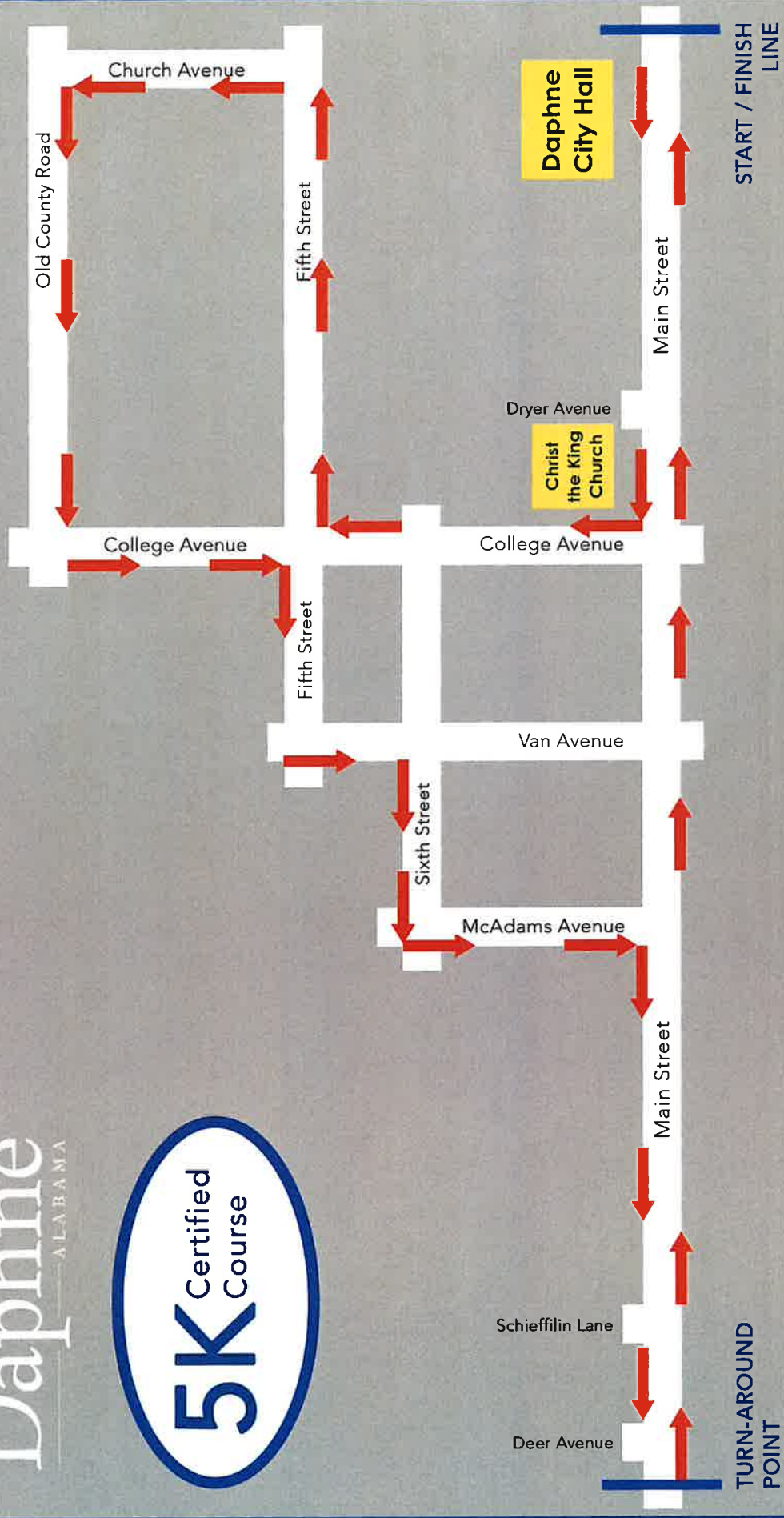

WHEREAS, an appropriation of \$500,000 is needed from the General Fund for the required contribution towards the Milton Jones Road Extension project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA, that:

1. Funds in the amount of **\$500,000** from the **General Fund and transferred to the Capital Reserve Fund** are appropriated and made a part of the Fiscal Year 2025 budget for the Milton Jones Road Extension project.
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to do or perform or cause to be done or performed in the name of and behalf of the City such other acts, and to execute, deliver, file and record such other instruments, documents, certificates, notifications and related documents, all as shall be required by law or necessary or desirable to carry out the provisions and purposes of this resolution.

**A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL RESOLUTION 2018-01 REGARDING A TOBACCO
SURCHARGE FOR EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PARTICIPATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Daphne maintains a group health and dental care plan for its full-time employees and retirees, intended to encourage and acknowledge the loyalty and devotion of its workforce;

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution 2018-01, which imposed a monthly \$25 surcharge on employees and/or their dependent spouses who use tobacco products and are covered under the City's health and dental insurance plan, unless they certified that they did not use such products;

WHEREAS, since the adoption of Resolution 2018-01, there have been numerous legal developments, including enforcement actions by the U.S. Department of Labor and a wave of class action lawsuits alleging that tobacco surcharges imposed by employers may violate the nondiscrimination provisions of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA);

WHEREAS, although the City maintains that its surcharge policy has remained compliant with all applicable law, the City seeks to ensure that its employee benefits programs comply with all applicable laws, avoid unnecessary legal exposure, and continue to serve the best interests of the City, its employees, and retirees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Repeal of Tobacco Surcharge Policy.** Resolution 2018-01 is hereby repealed in its entirety, effective immediately.
2. **Employee Contributions.** The City will evaluate employee contributions for medical and dental insurance coverage through other compliant and equitable means, consistent with applicable federal law.

ORDINANCE 2025-16**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF DAPHNE'S
COMMUNITY STANDARDS ORDINANCE NO. 2013-38**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2013-38 was adopted to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the community by regulating the location of tattoo facilities in relation to schools, churches, parks, and residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that certain low-impact tattoo studios, particularly those operating privately, without signage, and by appointment only, do not present the same visibility or neighborhood compatibility concerns as traditional, publicly advertised facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to allow limited exemptions for such private studios while preserving the general applicability of distance restrictions to commercial tattoo establishments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after due consideration, has determined that certain revisions to the City of Daphne Community Standards Ordinance, Ordinance 2013-38, as adopted on July 15, 2013, and codified at Chapter 13, Article XV in the City's Code of Ordinances, are necessary for the proper administration of said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA as follows:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 13-343, TATTOO FACILITIES

Section 13-343 of the City of Daphne Code of Ordinances, entitled "Tattoo Facilities," is hereby amended by inserting the following subsection (d):

(d) *Exemption for Private, Signage-Free Tattoo Studios.* The distance requirements of subsection (a) shall not apply to any private tattoo facility that satisfies both of the following conditions:

- (1) No Signage: The tattoo facility does not display any signage visible from public streets or neighboring properties, including but not limited to permanent, temporary, painted, window, sidewalk, or freestanding signs, that contains the word "tattoo" or any term, symbol, or graphic commonly understood to advertise tattoo services.
- (2) Private Appointments Only: Services are offered exclusively by appointment, and the tattoo facility is not open to walk-in traffic or general public access.

Any tattoo facility seeking exemption under this subsection must file an annual declaration of compliance with the Revenue Officer. If the tattoo facility subsequently displays prohibited signage or opens to the public, the exemption shall be immediately revoked and the distance restrictions of this section shall apply in full.

SECTION 2. INCORPORATION IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be included in and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of Daphne, Alabama, as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be renumbered, if appropriate, to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

SECTION 3. NO OTHER CHANGES

The remaining provisions of Ordinance 2013-38 shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply to all other tattoo facilities not qualifying under subsection (d) of Section 13-343.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

The provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases, and parts thereof of this Ordinance are severable, and if any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or part thereof of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such ruling shall not affect any other provision, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or part thereof, since the same would have been enacted by the Council without the incorporation of any such unconstitutional or invalid provision, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or part thereof.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as provided by law.
